SWARAJ SHAKTI GIRLS FELLOWSHIP UPDATE

Q3 Highlights

- We recruited and enlisted the 9th cohort of 15 school dropout tribal girls (ages 18-22) for the Shakti Girls fellowship program from surrounding bastis and villages of Udaipur. They were supported in exploring and learning different skill areas such as art, upcycling and product design, healthy cooking, photography, organic farming and theatre. They also visited several different organisations around Udaipur including Tapovan Ashram Unschoolers Ecovillage, Sadhna Women's Handicrafts store, Jugaad Garage, Banyan Roots Organic Store, Jagran Jan Vikas Samiti traditional healers, local potter, documentary film festival, art galleries in the old city and organic farms. We had several special trainers run workshops for them - Megha Sharma (cooking), Sakib (organic farming), Gopalji (basic electrician), Shahruk (art), Ashutosh Pandey (theatre workshop), Walter Peter (theatre and leadership), Ashish Sharma (photography and filmmaking). Several of them participated in supporting community learning workshops with kids in local bastis and schools.
- We supported 11 advanced level tribal girls to deepen their knowledge and skills by working more intensely on different projects. These girls took on many projects with many of our partners in Udaipur. It is very powerful to witness their growth in leadership on the following:
 - Several advanced girls focused on developing their skills in organic farming and setting up a professional nursery with native species. They have been working closely as apprentices with professional organic farming consultant Sakib Khan who is managing 4 farms around Udaipur. They are also practicing their learning on Shikshantar farm.
 - The advanced girls conducted several mural painting projects around the city in schools and temples, including one paid project with a government school. One team of our alumni art girls was specially invited and paid by Shilpgram to paint the venue before the start of the Shilpgram mela.
 - A team of 8 advanced girls did a 15 day internship with Devilal Prajapat on traditional pottery before the Diwali festival.
 - A team of 6 advanced girls journeyed to Banswara Syntex to host a 3-day learning mela with staff, wives and children of the company.

- A team of 10 girls worked with theatre director Ashutosh Pandey for 3 weeks on a theatre production called Riverview Apts. It was performed in 2 schools and 3 neighbourhoods.
 - The advanced girls helped to organise and host the Winter Millets Festival in collaboration with Banyan Roots. Over 450 people attended the festival in Shikshantar which featured more than 30 dishes made from millets like ragi, jowar, china, bajra and sama. The advanced girls helped with decoration, registration, media and cooking. There was 5 food stalls hosted by the girls-chefs.
 - A team advanced girls fellows led and conducted creativity workshops with 130+ children in 4 local bastis (Devali, Badgaon, Kavita and Neemach Kheda) and with 320+ girls in 5 government schools (Pulla, Badi, Sukher, Dewali and Bedla);
 - The advanced girls hosted several stalls as part of Christmas Giving Festival in Third Space (Secure Meters) for children and families. They interacted with over 100 visitors.
 - The advanced girls-chefs have been running weekly gift culture Ram Rasorda food stalls in the spirit of Langar. They feed an average about 100 people in 2 stalls per week at different locations around the city - over 1000 people total in the quarter were introduced to millets. They are able to connect with and inspire many other housewives and motheres and promote International Year of Millets. The advance girl-chefs also led and organised the cooking team for 10 Hulchul Cafes at Shikshantar with over 500 people. Another team of girl-chefs has started running paid food stalls on the street once per week.
- We started recruiting next 10th cohort of girls for Q2 fellowship.
